MANAGING ATTORNEY

The Center for Arkansas Legal Services is seeking a Managing Attorney for its Little Rock area office. Applicants must be licensed to practice law in Arkansas; have a desire to work with low income clients; and have a commitment to providing high quality, aggressive advocacy.

Duties include managing a six county service area headquartered in Little Rock; supervising legal and support staff; representing low-income clients in civil cases; responsible for grant oversight; directing the in-house VOCALS pro bono referral activities; conducting community outreach and engagement projects; and other duties as assigned. Managerial and organizational experience is desired, plus experience in trial and appellate courts. Ability to speak Spanish is a plus.
